Guest Players Please remember it is a requirement (Law 7) that players should only play for **ONE TEAM** in this league unless they arrange to play as the one permitted **GUEST** for another team in a particular fixture. GUEST players are only permitted if the permission is given by the League Secretary (acting as League Officer) or the Deputy Divisional Officer and the opposition. Alternatively, players can make a single **informed transfer** between clubs during the season.
